8 SYNOPSIS: This bill would propose an amendment to the  
9 Constitution of Alabama of 1901, to provide for the  
10 appointment of the Walker County Board of  
11 Registrars by the judge of probate, the sheriff,  
12 and the circuit clerk.

15 TO BE ENTITLED  
16 AN ACT

18 To propose an amendment to the Constitution of  
19 Alabama of 1901, to provide for the appointment of the Walker  
20 County Board of Registrars by the judge of probate, the  
21 sheriff, and the circuit clerk.

22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

23 Section 1. The following amendment to the  
24 Constitution of Alabama of 1901, is proposed and shall become  
25 valid as a part of the Constitution when all requirements of  
26 this act are fulfilled:

27 PROPOSED AMENDMENT

1 (a) The members of the Walker County Board of  
2 Registrars shall be appointed as follows: The judge of probate  
3 shall appoint one member, the sheriff shall appoint one  
4 member, and the circuit clerk shall appoint one member. The  
5 members shall elect a chair from among the membership.

6 (b) All provisions of Article 1, Chapter 3, Title  
7 17, Code of Alabama 1975, not in direct conflict with this  
8 amendment shall be applicable to the Walker County Board of  
9 Registrars.

10 Section 2. An election upon the proposed amendment  
11 shall be held in accordance with Amendment 555 to the  
12 Constitution of Alabama of 1901, now appearing as Section  
13 284.01 of the Official Recompilation of the Constitution of  
14 Alabama of 1901, as amended, and the election laws of this  
15 state.

16 Section 3. The appropriate election official shall  
17 assign a ballot number for the proposed constitutional  
18 amendment on the election ballot and shall set forth the  
19 following description of the substance or subject matter of  
20 the proposed constitutional amendment:

21 "Relating to Walker County, proposing an amendment  
22 to the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, to provide for the  
23 appointment of the Walker County Board of Registrars by the  
24 judge of probate, the sheriff, and the circuit clerk.

25 "Proposed by Act \_\_\_\_\_."

26 This description shall be followed by the following  
27 language:
