4 Section 1. Section 16-24-12 of the Code of Alabama 5 1975, is amended to read as follows:

"\$16-24-12.

7 "Any teacher in the public schools, whether in continuing service status or not, shall be deemed offered 8 reemployment for the succeeding school year at the same 9 10 salary, including salary earned through a supplemental position, unless the employing board of education shall cause 11 12 notice in writing to be given said the teacher on or before 13 the last day of the term of the school in which the teacher is 14 employed; and such. Such teacher shall be presumed to have 15 accepted such employment unless he or she shall notify the employing board of education in writing to the contrary on or 16 17 before the fifteenth day of June. The employing board of education shall not cancel the contract of any teacher in 18 continuing service status, nor cause notice of nonemployment 19 to be given to any teacher whether in continuing service 20 21 status or not except by a vote of a majority of its members 22 evidenced by the minute entries of said the board made prior 23 to or at the time of any such action."

24 Section 2. This act shall become effective 25 immediately following its passage and approval by the 26 Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
