2 ENROLLED, An Act,

3 Relating to Calhoun County; to provide for the
4 reimbursement of the office of revenue commissioner for any
5 monetary loss up to a certain amount each year resulting from
6 the performance of official duties for certain errors or
7 mistakes made in good faith.

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

9 Section 1. The provisions of this act shall apply
10 only to Calhoun County.

11 Section 2. The Calhoun County Commission shall
12 reimburse the office of revenue commissioner from the general
13 fund of Calhoun County up to two thousand five hundred dollars
14 (\$2,500) per year for the amount of any loss, by the office or
15 the revenue commissioner, arising or caused by error, mistake,
16 or omission, in the office of the revenue commissioner, caused
17 without the revenue commissioner's personal knowledge,
18 including loss arising from acceptance by the office of the
19 revenue commissioner of worthless or forged checks, drafts,
20 money orders, or other written orders for money or its
21 equivalent.

22 Section 3. It shall be the duty of the revenue
23 commissioner to insure that his or her employees exercise due
24 care in performing their duties and to make a diligent effort
25 to correct the error, mistake, or omission and collect the

1 amount subject to potential loss immediately upon becoming
2 aware of the potential loss. This act shall not apply to any
3 deliberate misuse or misappropriation of funds by the revenue
4 commissioner or any clerk or employee of his or her office.

5 Section 4. This act shall become effective
6 immediately following its passage and approval by the
7 Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
