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2 ENROLLED, An Act,

Relating to Pickens County; to provide for a drug enforcement fee in certain cases in the circuit, district, and municipal courts; and to provide for the distribution of the fee.

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

8 Section 1. In all juvenile, traffic, criminal, and quasi-criminal cases in the juvenile, district, circuit, and 9 municipal courts in Pickens County, a docket fee, hereinafter 10 11 referred to as a drug enforcement fee, shall be assessed in 12 each case. The drug enforcement fee shall be in an amount 13 equal to twenty dollars (\$20) in each non-drug case, 14 seventy-five dollars (\$75) in each misdemeanor drug case, and 15 one hundred dollars (\$100) in each felony drug case. The fees, 16 when collected, shall be distributed monthly as follows: Five 17 dollars (\$5) of the fees assessed in each case shall be 18 retained by the clerk of the court as an administrative fee. 19 Ten dollars (\$10) of the fees assessed in each case in the 20 municipal courts shall be distributed to the appropriate fund established by the chief of police of the municipality and 21 expended at his or her discretion for law enforcement 22 23 purposes. Ten dollars (\$10) assessed in each case in the circuit or district court shall be distributed to the Pickens 24 County Sheriff's Law Enforcement Fund for law enforcement 25

purposes. The remainder of the fee shall be distributed to the
Drug Enforcement Fund established by the district attorney.

3 Section 2. The drug enforcement fee shall be collected as prescribed in Section 1 in all cases where the 4 5 defendant is adjudged guilty, a bond forfeited, a penalty imposed, or where there is issued any alias or capias warrant 6 7 of arrest, or in any other case where court costs are 8 assessed, whether a defendant is adjudged guilty or not. The drug enforcement fee shall be in addition to and not in lieu 9 of any other fees or costs, and shall not be waived or 10 11 remitted unless all other costs and charges of court are 12 waived.

13 Section 3. The District Attorney for the 24th 14 Judicial Circuit shall establish a separate fund to be called the Pickens County Drug Enforcement Fund. All sums collected 15 16 and deposited into the fund pursuant this act may be expended 17 by the district attorney for the support of the drug task 18 force that serves the 24th Judicial Circuit, including, but 19 not limited to, the payment of any and all expenses incurred 20 by the drug task force, the payment of any matching monies 21 required under the terms of any grant that may be awarded by 22 any governmental or other entity for the support of the drug 23 task force, the payment or supplementing of salaries for 24 personnel of the drug task force, or for any other law 25 enforcement purpose.

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Section 4. This act shall become effective on the
first day of the third month following its passage and
approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
