ENROLLED, An Act,

Relating to Pickens County; to amend Section 2 of Act 2007-277, 2007 Regular Session (Acts 2007, p. 376), to provide further for the collection of the solicitor's fee.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

Section 1. Section 2 of Act 2007-277, 2007 Regular Session (Acts 2007, p. 376), is amended to read as follows:

"Section 2. The solicitor's fee shall be collected as prescribed in Section 1 in all criminal cases where the defendant is adjudged guilty, a bond forfeited, a penalty imposed, or where there is issued any alias or capias warrant of arrest, or in any other case where court costs are assessed, whether a defendant is adjudged guilty or not. The solicitor's fee shall be in addition to and not in lieu of any other fees or costs. The solicitor's fee shall not be waived or remitted unless all other costs and charges of court are waived."

Section 2. This act shall become effective on the first day of the third month following its passage and approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
