16	To provide for a salary increase for certain
17	employees of the Department of Corrections.
18	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:
19	Section 1. (a) Effective with the first payday on or
20	after October 1, 2011, all Merit System employees of the
21	Department of Corrections who, as a part of their normal and
22	customary job duties, work inside a correctional facility
23	under the care, custody, and control of the department,
24	including, but not limited to, work release centers, shall
25	receive a one-step, 2.5 percent, salary increase. The salary
26	increases provided herein shall not affect normal annual merit
27	raise considerations. The salary increases shall continue on

the first payday on or after each succeeding October 1st at a rate of one-step, 2.5 percent, for each year the General Fund is not in proration, until such time as the total of such salary increases equals 10 percent, excluding normal merit raises and cost-of-living adjustments, if any occur.

6 (b) The Director of the State Personnel Department 7 shall revise the classifications, schedule of rates, and 8 ranges set forth in the pay plan for affected Merit System 9 employees of the Department of Corrections to reflect the 10 increases provided in subsection (a) and shall send the 11 revised classifications, rates, and ranges to the Comptroller 12 who shall issue warrants in accordance therewith.

Section 2. This act shall become effective
immediately following its passage and approval by the
Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
