9		keeping a cockpit and cockfighting.
10		This bill would further provide for the
11		crime of owning or operating a cockpit with
12		penalties and would fine a spectator or a person in

14		Amendment 621 of the Constitution of Alabama
15		of 1901, now appearing as Section 111.05 of the
16		Official Recompilation of the Constitution of
17		Alabama of 1901, as amended, prohibits a general
18		law whose purpose or effect would be to require a
19		new or increased expenditure of local funds from
20		becoming effective with regard to a local
21		governmental entity without enactment by a 2/3 vote
22		unless: it comes within one of a number of
23		specified exceptions; it is approved by the
24		affected entity; or the Legislature appropriates
25		funds, or provides a local source of revenue, to
26		the entity for the purpose.

1	The purpose or effect of this bill would be	
2	to require a new or increased expenditure of local	
3	funds within the meaning of the amendment. However,	
4	the bill does not require approval of a local	
5	governmental entity or enactment by a 2/3 vote to	
6	become effective because it comes within one of the	
7	specified exceptions contained in the amendment.

13	To amend Section 13A-12-4 of the Code of Alabama	
14	1975, relating to keeping a cockpit and cockfighting; to	
15	further provide for the crime of owning or operating a cockpit	
16	with penalties; to fine a spectator or person in attendance;	
17	and in connection therewith would have as its purpose or	
18	effect the requirement of a new or increased expenditure of	
19	local funds within the meaning of Amendment 621 of the	
20	Constitution of Alabama of 1901, now appearing as Section	
21	111.05 of the Official Recompilation of the Constitution of	
22	Alabama of 1901, as amended.	
23	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:	
24	Section 1. Section 13A-12-4 of the Code of Alabama	
25	1975, is amended to read as follows:	

"\$13A-12-4.

"Any person who keeps a cockpit or who in any public place fights cocks shall, on conviction, be fined not less than \$20.00 nor more than \$50.00. owns or operates a cockpit, upon conviction, is guilty of a Class A misdemeanor with a fine of not less than ten thousand dollars (\$10,000). Any spectator or person in attendance shall be fined one thousand dollars (\$1,000)."

Section 2. Although this bill would have as its purpose or effect the requirement of a new or increased expenditure of local funds, the bill is excluded from further requirements and application under Amendment 621, now appearing as Section 111.05 of the Official Recompilation of the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, as amended, because the bill defines a new crime or amends the definition of an existing crime.

Section 3. This act shall become effective on the first day of the third month following its passage and approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
