8	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:
9	Section 1. Section 45-9-245.02 of the Code of
10	Alabama 1975, is amended to read as follows:
11	"§45-9-245.02.
12	"The County Commission of Chambers County may levy,
13	in addition to all other taxes presently levied, an additional
14	sales and use tax not to exceed the highest municipal rates
15	collected in the county. These additional rates shall be as
16	follows: General sales, sales and use tax rate of a rate equal
17	to the highest municipal rate collected at the time of
18	enactment of this part; automobile sales and use rate of two
19	percent; agricultural machinery sales and use tax of two
20	percent; and manufacturing machine sales and use tax rate of
21	two percent. These <u>Except as herein provided, these</u> rates
22	shall apply only in the areas <u>in the county</u> outside the
23	corporate limits of Lanett, Valley, Lafayette, Waverly, and
24	Five Points <u>as determined on the effective date of</u> this the
25	<u>original act</u> adding this provision. These rates shall also

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apply to the area of the county which constitutes the police 1 jurisdiction for a municipality located outside the county 2 3 provided the municipality has a sales and use tax in effect in the police jurisdiction in the county on the effective date of 4 5 this the original act adding this provision. The additional sales and use tax rates in the county outside the corporate 6 limits of Lanett, Valley, Lafayette, Waverly, and Five Points, 7 8 as determined on the effective date of this the original act, but within their the respective police jurisdiction of Lanett, 9 Valley, Lafayette, Waverly, or Five Points, shall be only 10 11 one-half the corresponding municipal rates of the municipality having jurisdiction. The gross receipts of any business and 12 13 the gross proceeds of all sales, which are presently exempt under the state sales and use tax statutes, are exempt from 14 the tax authorized by this part." 15

16 Section 2. This act shall become effective 17 immediately following its passage and approval by the 18 Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
