ENROLLED, An Act,

Relating to Barbour County; to amend Section 45-3-232 of the Code of Alabama 1975, to authorize the Barbour County Commission to increase the fee for a pistol permit; and to provide for distribution of the fee.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

Section 1. Section 45-3-232 of the Code of Alabama 1975, is amended to read as follows:

"§45-3-232.

"(a) In Barbour County the fee for issuance of a permit to carry a pistol in a vehicle or concealed on or about the person as provided in Section 13A-11-75 shall be fifteen dollars (\$15) which shall be collected by the sheriff, or his or her agent.

"(b) Nine dollars (\$9) of each fee collected under subsection (a) shall be paid to the county treasury which shall be used for the specific purpose of motor vehicle purchases for the Barbour County Sheriff's Department. The remaining six dollars (\$6) of each fee shall be deposited by the Sheriff of Barbour County, or his or her agent, in any bank located in Barbour County into a fund known as the Sheriff's Fund.

"(c) The Sheriff's Fund provided for in subsection (b) shall be drawn upon by the Sheriff of Barbour County or

1 his or her appointed agent and shall be used exclusively for  
2 law enforcement purposes and in the discharge of the sheriff's  
3 office as he or she sees fit.

4 "(d) The establishment of the Sheriff's Fund as  
5 provided in this section and the use of such funds shall in no  
6 way diminish or take the place of any other imbursement or  
7 other source of income established for the sheriff or the  
8 operation of his or her office.

9 "(e) Effective after August 1, 2010, the Barbour  
10 County Commission by resolution of the commission may increase  
11 the fee for the issuance of a pistol permit as provided for in  
12 Section 13A-11-75, by five dollars (\$5). The additional fee  
13 when collected by the sheriff shall be deposited in the county  
14 treasury and used only for the purchase and maintenance of  
15 motor vehicles for the Barbour County Sheriff's Department.  
16 The additional fee when adopted by the county commission shall  
17 not be effective prior to the first day of the month  
18 thereafter or at a later time designated in the resolution."

19 Section 2. This act shall become effective  
20 immediately following its passage and approval by the  
21 Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
