2 AN ACT

To require the membership of the Good Faith Effort
Committee established within the Alabama Department of
Transportation pursuant to 49 CFR Part 26 to be inclusive and
reflect the racial, gender, geographic, urban/rural, and
economic diversity of the state; and to require the committee
to annually report to the Legislature by the second
legislative day of each regular session the extent to which
the committee has complied with the diversity provisions
provided for in this act.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

Section 1. The membership of the Good Faith Effort Committee established within the Alabama Department of Transportation pursuant to 49 CFR Part 26 whose duty is to determine whether a Disadvantaged Business Enterprise bidder who has not met the contract goal has documented sufficient good faith efforts to be regarded as responsive shall be inclusive and reflect the racial, gender, geographic, urban/rural, and economic diversity of the state. The committee shall annually report to the Legislature by the second legislative day of each regular session the extent to which the committee has complied with the diversity provisions provided for in this act.

Section 2. This act shall become effective on the first day of the third month following its passage and approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
