13 Relating to all counties which had a population of
14 not less than 78,000 nor more than 81,000 persons according to
15 the 2000 federal decennial census; to provide for the
16 application of any transient occupancy taxes in the county to
17 persons charging fees for persons to camp on their property
18 under certain conditions.

19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

20 Section 1. In all counties which had a population of
21 not less than 78,000 nor more than 81,000 persons according to
22 the 2000 federal decennial census, the transient occupancy tax
23 levied pursuant to Chapter 26, Title 40, Code of Alabama 1975;
24 levied pursuant to local law; or levied by any municipality
25 shall not apply to any person or persons who allow persons to
26 camp on their property for a fee, including parking motor
27 homes or other similar camping vehicles on the property, when

1 the use of the property is not allowed on a regular basis, but
2 only intermittently, or is not allowed for more than 14 days
3 each year.

4 Section 2. The provisions of this act are severable.
5 If any part of this act is declared invalid or
6 unconstitutional, that declaration shall not affect the part
7 which remains.

8 Section 3. All laws or parts of laws which conflict
9 with this act are repealed.

10 Section 4. This act shall become effective
11 immediately following its passage and approval by the
12 Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
