26	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

Section 1. Section 16-13A-11 of the Code of Alabama
 1975, is amended to read as follows:

"§16-13A-11.

"No individual member of a local board of education 4 shall be held financially liable for misappropriation of funds 5 of the local board of education unless the individual acts 6 7 willfully, maliciously, fraudulently, in bad faith beyond his or her authority, or pursuant to a mistaken interpretation of 8 the law. The local superintendent of education and each 9 10 individual member of the local board of education may be held 11 personally liable for the mismanagement of funds of the local board of education." 12

Section 2. This act shall become effective
immediately following its passage and approval by the
Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
