8 SYNOPSIS: Under existing law, the Alabama Electronic  
9 Security Board of Licensure licenses locksmiths.

10 This bill would provide that a locksmith who  
11 has been licensed for ten years or more as a  
12 locksmith or who submits a notarized affidavit from  
13 another locksmith that he or she has 10 years or  
14 more experience as a locksmith shall be exempt from  
15 any continuing education requirements adopted by  
16 the board.

22 Relating to locksmiths; to provide that certain  
23 locksmiths shall be exempt from any continuing education  
24 requirements adopted by the Alabama Electronic Security Board  
25 of Licensure.

26 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

1                   Section 1. A locksmith who has been licensed for 10  
2 years or more as a locksmith or who submits a notarized  
3 affidavit from another locksmith that he or she has 10 years  
4 or more experience as a locksmith shall be exempt from any  
5 continuing education requirements adopted by the Alabama  
6 Electronic Security Board of Licensure.

7                   Section 2. This act shall become effective on the  
8 first day of the third month following its passage and  
9 approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
