All such claims shall 18 be presented in the form prescribed by the awarding authority, 19 and proof of the facts and circumstances of the peace officer's or firefighter's death and, if necessary, the 20 21 claimant's relationship to and dependence upon such peace 22 officer or firefighter shall be made in the manner prescribed 23 by the awarding authority. "(b) Notwithstanding the provisions of subsection 24

25 (a), any person who was previously ineligible to claim the

compensation provided in this article, but is now eligible to 1 2 claim the compensation provided in this article because of the 3 enactment of Act 2008-480, and who is making a claim based upon the death of a peace officer or firefighter who died on 4 5 or after January 1, 2006, but prior to the enactment of Act 2008-480, shall be able to present his or her claim for 6 7 compensation to the awarding authority within one year of the 8 date of enactment of Act 2008-480 regardless of whether the claim was presented within one year from the date of the death 9 10 of the peace officer or firefighter.

"(c) The awarding authority is hereby authorized to prescribe such forms and adopt such rules of evidence and procedure as it deems necessary or proper, not inconsistent with the provisions of this article, for the proper determination of all claims for compensation under this article."

17 Section 2. This act shall become effective 18 immediately following its passage and approval by the 19 Governor, or its otherwise becoming law and shall be 20 retroactive to January 1, 2007.
