15	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:
16	Section 1. (a) All contracts governed by Titles 39
17	and 41 of the Code of Alabama 1975, involving seven thousand
18	five hundred dollars (\$7,500) or more, made by or on behalf of
19	any state department, board, bureau, commission, committee,
20	institution, including the Legislature and colleges and
21	universities governed by a board of trustees or the Department
22	of Postsecondary Education, corporation, authority, or office
23	shall include the following:
24	(1) Contractors shall provide, to the awarding
25	authority or purchasing agent, as applicable, a written list
26	identifying contractors, subcontractors, and suppliers, and
27	their owners and primary places of business, for all

subcontracts or purchase orders that exceed seven thousand five hundred dollars (\$7,500).

3 (2) Contractors shall supply this list within 20
4 days after the execution of the contract.

5 (3) Contractors shall amend this list within 10 days
6 after any change involving a subcontractor or a supplier.

7 (b) Failure to provide the requirements listed in8 this section may result in the cancellation of the contract.

9 (c) With each application for payment, the
10 contractor shall furnish an affidavit listing the following:

11 (1) The number and name of every subcontractor12 associated with the work.

13 (2) Every person furnishing labor or materials for
14 the work, and verification that every employee of the
15 contractor and subcontractor are legally present in this
16 state.

17 (3) The amounts due or to become due to the
18 subcontractors, laborers, or material suppliers as of the date
19 of the application for payment.

20 Section 2. This act shall apply to all contracts 21 described in Section 1 that are in existence on the effective 22 date of this act, and that have not been fully completed.

23 Section 3. The Comptroller shall include on the 24 Internet database for state expenditures a listing of all 25 subcontractors for public contracts. Section 4. This act shall become effective on the
 first day of the third month following its passage and
 approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
