2.6	RE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA.

Section 1. There is created an additional circuit judgeship for the Twenty-seventh Judicial Circuit which shall be designated judgeship number 3. This judgeship shall be filled by election at the general election in 2012 following its preclearance under Section 5 of the Voting Rights Act of 1965, 42 U.S.C. § 1973c. The first judge elected pursuant to this section shall serve for a six-year term, holding office from the first Monday following the second Tuesday in January after the general election at which that judge is elected.

Section 2. The judge elected as provided in Section 1 shall have and shall exercise all the jurisdiction, power, rights, and authority and shall possess all of the qualifications, perform all of the duties, and shall be subject to all of the responsibilities and duties of the office to which other circuit judges are subject.

Section 3. The annual compensation of the circuit judge appointed or elected pursuant to this act shall be in accordance with Chapter 10A, Title 12, Code of Alabama 1975, including, but not limited to, the provisions that no circuit judge first elected or appointed to office after October 1, 2001, shall be provided a salary supplement or expense allowance.

Section 4. There is hereby appropriated from the State General Fund such additional funds as may be required, as determined by the Director of Finance, to fully fund the additional judgeship provided for by this act for the fiscal year the judgeship is filled pursuant to this act.

Section 5. This act shall become effective immediately following its passage and approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
