21	(2) ENTITY. A governmental entity or agency or
22	department of a governmental entity.
23	(3) LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCY. The Alabama Department
24	of Public Safety, the police department of each incorporated
25	city or municipality, the department of each sheriff of the
26	state, including all deputies sheriff, the enforcement
27	division of the Department of Conservation and Natural

Resources, and the Public Service Commission, and each public agency in the state charged with the enforcement of any laws and the officers and employees of which have the power as such to make arrests.

(4) LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER. An officer of a law enforcement agency.

Section 2. Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the contrary, no law enforcement agency, law enforcement officer, or other entity shall impose an accident response service fee on or from an insurance company, the driver or owner of a motor vehicle, or any other person or entity.

Section 3. The provisions of this act shall not apply to the Alabama Department of Environmental Management.

Section 4. This act shall become effective immediately following its passage and approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
