SYNOPSIS:           This bill would relate to any Class 3 municipality and would provide that the commissioners of any municipal housing authority composed of five members would be appointed by the city council.

A BILL  
TO BE ENTITLED  
AN ACT

Relating to Class 3 municipalities; to provide for the appointment of the commissioners of any municipal housing authority composed of five members.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

Section 1. (a) In any Class 3 municipality, the commissioners of any municipal housing authority organized under Article 2, Chapter 1, Title 24, Code of Alabama 1975 (commencing at Section 24-1-20), which has five commissioners shall be appointed as follows: Upon the expiration of the terms of any commissioner serving on the effective date of

1       this section, the commissioners appointed to fill any  
2       vacancies shall be appointed by the city council.

3               (b) This section shall not affect the number of  
4       commissioners serving on any municipal housing authority in  
5       any Class 3 municipality pursuant to Section 11-40-21, Code of  
6       Alabama 1975.

7               Section 2. All laws or parts of laws which conflict  
8       with this act are repealed.

9               Section 3. This act shall become effective on the  
10      first day of the third month following its passage and  
11      approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
