To amend Section 11-42-5 of the Code of Alabama 1975, to validate and ratify under certain conditions any municipal annexation by any municipality prior to the effective date of this act notwithstanding any procedural defect by the municipality.

10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

Section 1. Section 11-42-5 of the Code of Alabama

12 1975, is amended to read as follows:

"\$11-42-5.

"Every annexation undertaken prior to the effective date of the act adding this language, under any statutory procedure for annexation by any municipality and which the annexation procedure has been completed in compliance with the substantive requirements of the applicable annexation statute, notwithstanding any irregularity or defect in the procedure, is ratified and confirmed and given effect in all respects as if all provisions of law relating to the annexation proceeding had been duly and legally complied with. This section shall not apply to any annexation or attempted annexation which, prior to the effective date of the act adding this language, has been held invalid by the Supreme Court of Alabama or by

1	the Court of Civil Appeals of Alabama or by a final judgment
2	of the circuit court in the county in which the annexation was
3	completed and from which judgment an appeal was not taken to
