1 To amend Section 16-33A-1, Code of Alabama 1975, 2 relating to the Alabama Student Grant Program; to remove the term nonprofit from the definition of an approved institution; 3 4 to remove the qualifying requirement that an approved institution be formally seeking accreditation by the 5 6 Commission on Colleges of the Southern Association of Colleges 7 and Schools; and to provide further for the time when the acceptance of credits by other institutions is sufficient to 8 constitute an approved institution. 9 10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA: Section 1. Section 16-33A-1, Code of Alabama 1975, 11 12 is amended to read as follows: "\$16-33A-1. 13 14 "As used in this chapter, unless the context 15 requires otherwise, the following terms shall have the meanings respectively ascribed to them by this section: 16 17 "(1) ACHE. The Alabama Commission on Higher Education. 18 "(2) ALABAMA RESIDENT. A person who has been 19 domiciled in the State of Alabama for a period of at least 12 20 21 consecutive months immediately preceding application for a 22 grant under the Alabama Student Grant Program. The ACHE shall 23 promulgate and enforce regulations further defining and limiting the term "domicile" so as to limit the benefits of 24 25 this legislation to bona fide Alabama citizens, based upon 26 criteria including residency of parents and guardians, voter

registration of students and parents, drivers license
 registration and other facts indicating bona fide citizenship.

"(3) APPROVED INSTITUTION. Any independent nonprofit 3 4 postsecondary institution of higher learning located in the State of Alabama which is accredited by the Commission on 5 Colleges of the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools, 6 7 or which has entered into the formal process of attaining 8 accreditation by the Commission on Colleges of the Southern 9 Association of Colleges and Schools, or whose credits are 10 accepted by at least three other institutions which are accredited by the Commission on Colleges of the Southern 11 12 Association of Colleges and Schools prior to the effective 13 date of this amendatory act. Such an approved institution must 14 have an academic curriculum which is not comprised principally 15 of sectarian instruction or preparation of students for a sectarian vocation and which does not award primarily 16 17 theologian or seminarian degrees. To the extent that any such institution may have a religious or denominational 18 affiliation, it must perform essentially secular educational 19 functions which are distinct and separable from religious 20 21 activity. Such an approved institution must not discriminate 22 in its admissions practices on the basis of religious or 23 denominational preference. No independent postsecondary 24 institution of higher learning shall be considered an approved 25 institution during any fiscal year in which it receives a 26 direct appropriation from the State of Alabama. Nothing contained herein shall be construed to limit, replace or 27

diminish any direct state appropriation now being made or which shall hereafter be made to any independent institution of higher learning.

4 "(4) ELIGIBLE STUDENT. Any applicant for a grant
5 under the Alabama Student Grant Program who:

6 "a. Has obtained a certificate of graduation from a 7 secondary school or the recognized equivalent of such 8 graduation; and

9 "b. Is classified as an undergraduate student, as 10 defined in this chapter; and

11 "c. Is an Alabama resident, as defined in this12 chapter; and

"d. Is a citizen of the United States or in the
process of becoming a citizen of the United States; and

15 "e. Is enrolled or accepted for enrollment as a 16 full-time or part-time student in a program of at least six 17 months' duration in an approved institution as defined in this 18 chapter; and

19 "f. Is not enrolled and does not intend to enroll in 20 a course of study leading to an undergraduate degree in 21 theology or divinity.

"(5) FULL-TIME STUDENT. An individual student who meets the criteria established by definitions, rules and regulations to be established by the ACHE.

"(6) GRANT. A monetary award under the Alabama
Student Grant Program to an approved institution on behalf of

and to the credit of an eligible student pursuant to this
 chapter.

"(7) INSTITUTIONAL RELATED EXPENSES. Nonsectarian
educational expenses, including, but not limited to, tuition,
mandatory fees, room and board, transportation, books and
supplies and other incidental nonsectarian education expenses
anticipated by an eligible student.

8 "(8) PART-TIME STUDENT. An individual student who 9 meets all qualifications as an eligible student and who meets 10 the further criteria to be established by the ACHE.

"(9) PROGRAM. The Alabama Student Grant Program,including the administration thereof.

13 "(10) UNDERGRADUATE STUDENT. Any individual student 14 who meets all other qualifications as an eligible student and 15 has not received a baccalaureate degree or its equivalent."

16 Section 2. This act shall become effective on the 17 first day of the third month following its passage and 18 approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
