| 13 | and Gas Fitters Examining Board until October 1, 2011, with    |
| 14 | the additional recommendation for statutory change as set out  |
| 15 | in Section 3.                                                  |
| 16 | Section 2. The existence and functioning of the                |
| 17 | Plumbers and Gas Fitters Examining Board, created and          |
| 18 | functioning pursuant to Sections 34-37-1 to 34-37-18,          |
| 19 | inclusive, Code of Alabama 1975, is continued until October 1, |
| 20 | 2011, and those code sections are expressly preserved.         |
| 21 | Section 3. Section 34-37-3 of the Code of Alabama              |
| 22 | 1975, is amended to read as follows:                           |
| 23 | "§34-37-3.                                                     |
| 24 | "The board members established by this chapter,                |
| 25 | shall continue to serve on the hoard as renamed by this        |

chapter until the expiration of their current terms. 1 2. Appointments shall be subject to confirmation by the Senate. 3 Commencing on the effective date of the act amending this section, members shall serve until the expiration of their 4 5 respective terms of office and shall vacate office on that date. The Governor shall designate the length of term for each 6 7 of his appointees not to exceed four years. The board shall 8 always be composed of the following members: One member 9 appointed by the Governor shall be a master plumber as defined 10 by this chapter; one member appointed by the Governor shall be 11 a journeyman plumber as defined by this chapter; one member 12 appointed by the Governor shall be a registered professional 13 engineer licensed as such by the State Board of Registration 14 of Professional Engineers and Land Surveyors as provided in 15 Article 2 of Chapter 11 of this title, or any subsequent act 16 relating to the licensing of professional engineers; one 17 member appointed by the Governor shall be a municipal or 18 county building official; one member appointed by the Governor 19 shall be a master gas fitter as defined in this chapter; one 20 member appointed by the Governor shall be a journeyman gas 2.1 fitter as defined in this chapter; and one member appointed by 22 the Governor shall be appointed from the public at large. The 23 member representing the public at large shall not be engaged 24 or otherwise connected to the plumbing or gas industry or the 25 installation of plumbing or gas work nor connected with any
