17	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:
18	Section 1. Pursuant to the Alabama Sunset Law, the
19	Sunset Committee recommends the continuance of the Office of
20	Information Technology until October 1, 2012, with the
21	additional recommendation for statutory change as set out in
22	Section 3.
23	Section 2. The existence and functioning of the
24	Office of Information Technology, created and functioning
25	pursuant to Sections 16-61D-1 to 16-61D-6, inclusive, Code of
26	Alabama 1975, is continued until October 1, 2012, and those

code sections are expressly preserved.

Section 3. Section 16-61D-5 of the Code of Alabama 1 2 1975, is amended to read as follows: "\$16-61D-5. 3 "(a) There is hereby created an Information Technology Council to benefit the Office of Information 5 6 Technology. The membership of the council shall be inclusive 7 and reflect the racial, gender, geographic, urban/rural, and economic diversity of the state. The Information Technology 8 Council shall consist of individuals who are citizens of this 9 10 state possessing knowledge and skills in educational technology, selected in the following manner stipulated 11 12 herewith: 13 "(1) Seven representatives of four-year public 14 universities appointed by the Council of College and University Presidents. 15 "(2) The Executive Director of the Alabama 16 17 Commission on Higher Education and the Chancellor of the two-year college system as ex-officio members. 18 "(3) The State Superintendent of Education shall 19 appoint three public classroom teachers, two two-year college 20 21 presidents, and three representatives from the State 22 Department of Education. "(4) The Speaker of the House of Representatives 23

"(5) The President of the Senate shall appoint one

1 "(6) The President Pro Tempore of the Senate shall 2 appoint one member. "(b) The Information Technology Council shall 3 participate in the development and implementation of the 5 statewide information technology plan." Section 4. The Legislature concurs in the 6 7 recommendations of the Sunset Committee as provided in Sections 1, 2, and 3. 8 Section 5. This act shall become effective 9 10 immediately upon its passage and approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law. 11
