16	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:		
17	Section 1. This act may be cited as the "Graduate		
18	Degree Scholarship for Nurses."		
19	Section 2. Sections 34-21-60, 34-21-61, 34-21-62,		
20	and 34-21-63 of the Code of Alabama 1975, are amended to read		
21	as follows:		
22	"§34-21-60.		
23	"There shall be established for the fiscal year		
24	ending September 30, $\frac{1978}{2010}$, $\frac{15}{15}$ scholarships for		
25	post-baccalaureate graduate education of nurses. These		
26	scholarships shall be awarded to applicants from the State of		
27	Alabama at large. They shall be distributed, insofar as		

1	practicable, throughout the state. <u>The number of scholarships</u>		
2	shall equal five percent of the total enrollment in graduate		
3	nursing programs in Alabama. Each scholarship is limited to		
4	ten thousand dollars (\$10,000).		
5	" §34-21-61.		
6	"(a) To be eligible to receive a scholarship		
7	provided by this article, a person must have been an applicant		
8	must meet all of the following requirements:		
9	" <u>(1) Be</u> a resident of the State of Alabama for a		
10	period of at least one year immediately preceding the time of		
11	making application, .		
12	" <u>(2)</u> must be <u>Be</u> a person of good character. and		
13	shall have		
14	"(3) Have an active, unencumbered license as a		
15	professional nurse in Alabama.		
16	" <u>(4)</u> been <u>Be</u> accepted for matriculation in a <u>an</u>		
17	Alabama graduate nursing program conducted by an accredited		
18	school of nursing, must hold a baccalaureate degree in nursing		
19	from an accredited nursing school and must college or		
20	university.		
21	"(5) agree Agree to practice professional nursing in		
22	the State of Alabama for at least one year <u>two years</u> after		
23	completing the course in graduate study <u>degree</u> .		
24	"(b) Preference shall be given to applicants		
25	pursuing a career in nursing education.		
26	"(c) These scholarships will be available to		
27	students applicants seeking master's or doctorate degrees in		

nursing. <u>Doctorate degrees in education are also acceptable</u> provided the applicant holds a graduate degree in nursing.

"(d) Application for these scholarships shall be made to the Alabama Board of Nursing. The Board of Nursing shall receive five percent of the total appropriation to administer the scholarships.

"Each scholarship provided for by this article shall be in the amount of \$3,800.00 not exceed ten thousand dollars (\$10,000) per year, payable from funds appropriated to the Alabama Board of Nursing for this purpose. Contingent upon subsequent legislative funding of this program, a scholarship may either be renewed by the Alabama Board of Nursing for the same student or awarded to another applicant for the scholarship. Criteria for the selection of recipients and awarding of the scholarships shall be established by the Alabama Board of Nursing. These criteria shall be used as guides in the selection of the scholarship recipients from the various geographical areas of the state. In case a scholarship student fails to complete the course prescribed for a graduate degree in nursing, that student shall repay the amount of any scholarship funds received hereunder to the State Treasury. In the event of the scholarship recipient's death, the obligation for funds disbursed and not repaid shall be cancelled. In the event the scholarship recipient becomes mentally or physically impaired and is unable to complete a graduate course in nursing, or has received a graduate degree but is unable to

complete one year of service as a nurse due to such
disability, the obligation for funds disbursed and not repaid
shall be cancelled.

"There is hereby appropriated each year, beginning with the fiscal year ending September 30, 1978, to the Alabama Board of Nursing, out of any funds in the State Treasury to the credit of the Education Trust Fund, the sum of \$57,000.00, to be used solely for funding scholarships provided by this article. The appropriation provided in this section is in addition to any appropriations heretofore made, or to be made, to the Alabama Board of Nursing for each fiscal year. The Legislature shall provide for annual appropriations from the Education Trust fund for nursing scholarships."

Section 3. This act shall become effective immediately following its passage and approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
