- (3) Participation in any extracurricular activity outside of the basic course of study in any primary, secondary, or public postsecondary educational program.
- (b) The provisions of subsection (a) shall not apply to a student enrolled in a degree program at a public postsecondary educational institution in this state during the 2009-2010 school year or any prior year who received a resident tuition benefit pursuant to state law.

Section 2. This act shall become effective on the first day of the third month following its passage and approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
