1 (b) The proceeds of the application fees collected 2 pursuant to subsection (a) shall be deposited into the State 3 Treasury to the credit of the Probationer's Upkeep Fund. The 4 funds are hereby continuously appropriated to the Board of 5 Pardons and Paroles.

6 Section 2. This act shall become effective on the 7 first day of the third month following its passage and 8 approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
