Through this amendatory act, the Legislature intends that any otherwise valid contract for the purchase or sale of a lot or lots in a proposed subdivision entered into prior to September 4, 2009, and, any otherwise valid contract entered into after this amendatory act becomes effective, to convey, transfer, or to sell any land by reference to or exhibition of or by other use of a plat of a subdivision before such plat has been approved shall be valid and enforceable.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

Section 1. Section 11-52-33, Code of Alabama 1975, 2 is hereby amended to read as follows:

3 "\$11-52-33.

"Whoever, being the owner or agent of the owner of any land located within a subdivision, conveys, transfers, or sells or agrees to sell or negotiates to sell any land by reference to or exhibition of or by other use of a plat of a subdivision before such plat has been approved by the planning commission appropriate commission, department, or agency of any municipality requiring such approval and recorded or filed in the office of the appropriate county probate office shall forfeit and pay a penalty of \$100.00 for each lot or parcel so transferred or sold or agreed or negotiated to be sold, and the description of such lot or parcel by metes and bounds in the instrument of transfer or other document used in the process of selling or transferring shall not exempt the transaction from such penalties or from the remedies provided in this section.

"The municipal corporation municipality may enjoin such conveyance, transfer, or sale or agreement by a civil action for injunction brought in any court of competent jurisdiction or may recover the same penalty provided in this section by a civil action in any court of competent jurisdiction.

"Nothing in this section shall impair, impede, or prohibit any person or entity from entering into any otherwise

valid and enforceable contract for the purchase or sale of any 1 lot within any proposed subdivision prior to its approval." 2 Section 2. This act amending Section 11-52-33, code 3 of Alabama 1975, shall apply retroactively to all otherwise valid contracts entered into prior to September 4, 2009, and 5 those valid contracts entered into after the effective date of 6 7 this amendatory act. Section 3. The provisions of this amendatory act are 8 severable. If any part of this act is declared invalid or 9 10 unconstitutional, that declaration shall not affect the part 11 which remains. 12 Section 4. This act shall become effective 13 immediately following its passage and approval by the 14 Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
