ENROLLED, An Act,
To alter, rearrange, and extend the boundary lines and corporate limits of the City of Fort Payne in DeKalb County.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:
Section 1. The boundary lines and corporate limits of the City of Fort Payne in DeKalb County are altered, rearranged, and extended to include within the corporate limits of the municipality, in addition to the lands now included, all of the following territory:

Tract I:
A parcel of land located in a portion of the Southwest $1 / 4$ of the Northwest $1 / 4$ and a portion of the Northwest $1 / 4$ of the Southwest $1 / 4$ of Section 30, Township 7 South, Range 10 East, DeKalb County, Alabama, more particularly described as follows: Commence at the Northwest corner of Section 30 , said corner being an axle, thence on a State Plane east zone grid bearing of South 00²4'24" East along the West section line of Section 30 a distance of 1326.77 feet to a point; thence North $80^{\circ} 44^{\prime \prime} 58^{\prime \prime}$ East a
distance of 1145.08 feet to a 2 " capped pipe; thence South 00²4'15" East of 517.50 feet to a $2^{\prime \prime}$ capped pipe being on the South bank of Yellow Creek; this will be known as the point of beginning; from the point of beginning, thence South $00^{\circ} 24^{\prime \prime} 30^{\prime \prime}$ East a distance of 1843.92 feet to a 2 " capped pipe being on the North right-of-way of Highway 35; thence along the North right-of-way of Highway 35 on a chord bearing of North 71²5'49" West and a chord distance of 245.29 feet to a ${ }^{\circ}{ }^{\prime \prime}$ capped pipe; thence North 00²4'31" West a distance of 1892.25 feet to a $2^{\prime \prime}$ capped pipe, being on the South bank of Yellow Creek; thence South $61^{\circ} 41^{\prime \prime} 17$ " East a distance of 264.51 feet to the point of beginning. Said parcel containing 9.96 acres +/-.

## Tract II:

Commence at a $1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rebar in place accepted as the Northwest corner of the Southwest $1 / 4$ of the Northwest $1 / 4$ of Section 30, Township 7 South, Range 10 East, DeKalb County, Alabama, said point being the point of beginning. From this beginning point proceed North $88^{\circ} 41^{\prime} 38^{\prime \prime}$ East along the North boundary of said quarter-quarter section for a distance of 1145.96 feet to a 2" capped pipe in place; thence proceed South $00^{\circ} 26^{\prime \prime} 12$ " East for a distance of 517.86 feet to a wood stake in rock pile; thence proceed North 6142'13" West for a distance of 264.67 feet to a $2^{\prime \prime}$ capped pipe in place; thence proceed South 00²4'06" East for a distance of 1890.98 feet to
a 2" pipe in place, said point being located on the Northerly right-of-way of Alabama Highway No. 35; thence proceed Northwesterly along the Northerly right-of-way of said road for a chord bearing and distance of North 59¹9'26" West, 701.71 feet to a concrete right-of-way monument in place; thence proceed North 53¹0'34" West along the Northerly right-of-way of said road for a distance of 392.05 feet to a 1/2" capped rebar in place, said point being located on the West boundary of the Northwest $1 / 4$ of the Southwest $1 / 4$ of said Section 30 ; thence proceed North $00^{\circ} 25^{\prime \prime} 46^{\prime \prime}$ West along the West boundary of said Northwest $1 / 4$ of the Southwest 1/4 and the West boundary of the Southwest $1 / 4$ of the Northwest $1 / 4$ of said section for a distance of 1664.27 feet to the point of beginning. The above described land is located in the Southwest $1 / 4$ of the Northwest $1 / 4$ and the Northwest $1 / 4$ of the Southwest 1/4 of Section 30, Township 7 South, Range 10 East, DeKalb County, Alabama, and contains 44.37 acres. Tract III:

Commence at the northeast corner of Section 25, Township 7 South, Range 9 East of the Huntsville Meridian and proceed South $03^{\circ} 23^{\prime}$ West along the East boundary of said Section 25 for a distance of 2429.8 feet to a 2" galvanized pipe, said point being the point of beginning; thence continue South $03^{\circ} 23^{\prime}$ West along the East boundary of said Section 25 for a distance of 562.2 feet to a $1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ iron pin set with cap
on the northeast right-of-way boundary of Alabama Highway No. 35 (120 ft. ROW); thence leaving the East boundary of said Section 25, proceed North $48^{\circ} 29^{\prime}$ West along the northeast ROW boundary of said highway for a distance of 921.8 feet to an axle; thence leaving the northeast ROW boundary of said highway, proceed South $87^{\circ} 04^{\prime}$ East for a distance of 735.1 feet to the point of beginning. Said parcel of land lying in the Southeast Quarter of the Northeast Quarter and the Northeast Quarter of the Southeast Quarter of Section 25, Township 7 South, Range 9 East, DeKalb County, Alabama, and containing 4.74 acres, more or less.

Tract IV:
Commencing at the Northwest corner of the NE $1 / 4$ of the SE 1/4 of Section 35, Township 7 South, Range 9 East of the Huntsville Meridian and run East along the North line of said quarter section 378.2 feet to the point of beginning; thence East 284.6 feet; thence run South $0^{\circ} 1^{\prime \prime}$ East 201.0 feet; thence run South $32^{\circ}$ 42' $^{\prime}$ West 244.8 feet; thence run South $88^{\circ} 49^{\prime}$ West 140.0 feet; thence run North $0^{\circ} 33^{\prime}$ West 409.8 feet to the point of beginning and containing 2.33 acres, more or less.

Tract V:
The Northeast Quarter of the Southeast Quarter of Section Thirty-five (35), Township Seven (7) South, Range Nine
(9) East in DeKalb County, Alabama, containing forty (40) acres, more or less.

Tract VI:
All of Section 19, Township 6 South, Range 10 East, less the South $1 / 2$ of the $S W 1 / 4$ of the $S E 1 / 4$, and also less land described as: Beginning at the Northeast corner of said section, thence South 1525 feet; thence West 580 feet, thence Northeast 230 feet; thence West 230 feet; thence Northwest 1765 feet; thence East 1980 feet to the point of beginning, less road rights-of-way, and containing 584 acres, more or less, lying and being in DeKalb County, Alabama. Also the West $1 / 2$ of the SW $1 / 4$ and the $S W 1 / 4$ of the NW $1 / 4$ of Section 20, Township 6 South, Range 10 East, less a lot described as: Beginning 250 feet East of the Northeast corner of said forty; thence Southwest 200 feet; thence West 400 feet; thence North 200 feet; thence East 440 feet to the point of beginning, containing 116 acres, more or less, lying and being in DeKalb County, Alabama.

Tract VII:
The right-of-way of Alabama Highway \#35 from its intersection with the Eastern boundary of the City of Fort Payne to its intersection with the DeKalb County, Alabama/Cherokee County, Alabama, boundary. Tract VIII:

The right-of-way of DeKalb County Road \#78 from its intersection with Alabama Highway \#35 to its intersection with DeKalb County Road \#255.

Tract IX:
The right-of-way of DeKalb County Road \#255 from its intersection with DeKalb County Road \#78 to its intersection with Alabama Highway \#176.

Tract X:
The right-of-way of DeKalb County Road \#256 from its intersection with DeKalb County Road \#255 to its intersection with DeKalb County Road \#305.

Tract XI:
The right-of-way of DeKalb County Road \#89 from its intersection with the current corporate limits of the City of Fort Payne and southern boundary of DeSoto State Park to its intersection with DeKalb County Road \#305.

Section 2. In accordance with Section 11-42-6(b) of the Code of Alabama 1975, a map showing what territory is proposed to be annexed to the City of Fort Payne is on file in the office of the Judge of Probate in DeKalb County, Alabama, and the map is open to the inspection of the public.

Section 3. This act shall become effective immediately following its passage and approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
