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4 ENROLLED, An Act,

5 Relating to Jackson and DeKalb Counties; to
6 establish the Jackson/DeKalb Counties Industrial Development
7 Authority for the purpose of marketing and developing property
8 in the vicinity of Northeast Alabama Community College; and to
9 provide for the members of the authority and the operation of
10 the authority.

11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

12 Section 1. (a) There is established the
13 Jackson/DeKalb Counties Industrial Development Authority. The
14 purpose of the authority shall be to market and develop the
15 Northeast Alabama Technology Park on the Campbell site near
16 the Northeast Alabama Community College and other sites that
17 may be suitable for economic development in the future in the
18 vicinity of the college.

19 (b) The members of the authority shall consist of
20 the following:

21 (1) The President of the Northeast Alabama Community
22 College, who shall serve as chair of the authority.

23 (2) One member each appointed by the Jackson County
24 Commission.

1 (3) One member appointed by the DeKalb County
2 Commission.

3 (4) One member from each county appointed by the
4 state Senate Delegation representing Jackson and DeKalb
5 Counties.

6 (5) One member from each county appointed by the
7 state House of Representatives delegation representing Jackson
8 and DeKalb Counties.

9 (6) The President of the Jackson County Economic
10 Development Authority.

11 (7) The CEO/Executive Director of the DeKalb County
12 Economic Development Authority.

13 (8) The CEO of the Sand Mountain Electric Co-op.

14 (9) The CEO of the North Alabama Electric Co-op.

15 (c) The appointed members of the authority shall
16 serve for a term of four years and shall serve until a
17 successor is appointed.

18 (d) The authority shall have its first meeting at
19 the Northeast Alabama Community College at the call of the
20 chair. The college shall provide clerical assistance to the
21 authority. The authority may receive funding from any public
22 or private source.

23 (e) The membership of the authority shall be
24 inclusive and reflect the racial, gender, geographic,
25 urban/rural and economic diversity of these counties of the

1 State. The authority shall annually report to the Legislature
2 by the second legislative day of each regular session the
3 extent to which the authority has complied with the diversity
4 provisions provided for in this act.

5 Section 2. This act shall become effective on the
6 first day of the third month following its passage and
7 approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
