8 SYNOPSIS: Existing law allows the Department of
9 Conservation and Natural Resources to set the time
10 frame for hunting male whitetail deer.

11 This bill would extend the hunting season
12 for male whitetail deer through the first two weeks
13 after the close of regular gun season and would
14 impose additional fees for hunting during the
15 extended period.

21 Relating to hunting; to extend the hunting season
22 for male whitetail deer through the first two weeks after the
23 close of regular gun season; and to impose additional fees for
24 hunting during the extended period.

25 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

26 Section 1. (a) The Department of Conservation and
27 Natural Resources shall extend the gun hunting season for male

1 whitetail deer through the first two weeks after the close of
2 regular gun season, not to include hunting with dogs.

3 (b) An additional fee of twenty dollars (\$20) for
4 resident hunting licenses and one hundred twenty-five dollars
5 (\$125) for nonresident all game hunting licenses shall be
6 imposed and a notation shall be made on the license indicating
7 the license holder has paid to hunt during the first two weeks
8 after the close of regular gun deer hunting season.

9 (c) The department shall promulgate rules necessary
10 to implement this act.

11 Section 2. This act shall become effective on the
12 first day of the third month following its passage and
13 approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
