- (b) An additional fee of twenty dollars (\$20) for resident hunting licenses and one hundred twenty-five dollars (\$125) for nonresident all game hunting licenses shall be imposed and a notation shall be made on the license indicating the license holder has paid to hunt during the first two weeks after the close of regular gun deer hunting season.
- 9 (c) The department shall promulgate rules necessary to implement this act.

Section 2. This act shall become effective on the first day of the third month following its passage and approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
