13 Relating to Mobile County; authorizing the county  
14 board of education to allow persons employed as security  
15 personnel and resource officers to carry firearms while on  
16 duty and requiring that such employees have certain  
17 qualifications.

18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

19 Section 1. The Mobile County Board of Education may  
20 allow any person employed as security personnel or as resource  
21 officers by the board to carry a firearm while on duty if the  
22 employee meets the following qualifications:

23 (1) Has attended 16 hours of firearm training in a  
24 program approved by the Alabama Peace Officers Standards and  
25 Training Commission.

1                   (2) Annually completes and passes the firearm  
2 re-qualification required of law enforcement officers by the  
3 Alabama Peace Officers Standards and Training Commission.

4                   Section 2. This act shall become effective on the  
5 first day of the third month following its passage and  
6 approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
