shall become valid as a part thereof when approved by a majority of the qualified electors voting thereon and in accordance with Sections 284, 285, and 287 of the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, as amended:

PROPOSED AMENDMENT

Any other provision of law or of this Constitution notwithstanding, the Legislature may by appropriate laws authorize, tax, and regulate the game of chance commonly known as bingo, whether or not electronic, computer, or other technologic aids are used in connection with the game of bingo, in one or more locations in the state.

Section 2. An election upon the proposed amendment shall be held in accordance with Sections 284 and 285 of the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, now appearing as Sections 284 and 285 of the Official Recompilation of the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, as amended, and the election laws of this state.

Section 3. The appropriate election official shall assign a ballot number for the proposed constitutional amendment on the election ballot and shall set forth the following description of the substance or subject matter of the proposed constitutional amendment:

"Proposing an amendment to the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, to allow the Legislature to pass laws authorizing, taxing, and regulating bingo, whether or not electronic, computer, or other technologic aids are used in
