Section 1. There is created an additional circuit judgeship for the Twenty-eighth Judicial Circuit which shall be designated judgeship number 6. The additional judgeship is conditioned upon adoption of a resolution by the Baldwin County Commission to provide the necessary funding through 2014 for compensation and benefits of the judge filling the additional circuit judgeship, a judicial assistant, and a bailiff or law clerk for the judge.

Section 2. (a) This judgeship shall be filled at the general election in 2012 following its preclearance under Section 5 of the Voting Rights Act of 1965, 42 U.S.C. § 1973c and release of the conditional appropriation made by this act.

- (b) The first judge elected pursuant to this section shall serve for a six-year term, holding office from the first Monday following the second Tuesday in January after the general election at which that judge is elected.
- (c) The judge elected to circuit judgeship number 6 shall have and shall exercise all the jurisdiction, power, rights, and authority and shall possess all of the qualifications, perform all of the duties, and shall be subject to all of the responsibilities and duties of the office to which other circuit judges are subject.

Section 3. The annual compensation of the circuit judge appointed or elected pursuant to this act shall be in accordance with Chapter 10A, Title 12, Code of Alabama 1975, including, but not limited to, the provisions that no circuit judge first elected or appointed to office after October 1,
