25	Section 1. The following amendment to the
26	Constitution of Alabama of 1901, is proposed and shall become

valid as a part of the Constitution when all requirements of this act are fulfilled:

## PROPOSED AMENDMENT

Whenever a vacancy occurs in the office of the judge of probate, the revenue commissioner, or the sheriff in Greene County, with 12 months or more remaining on the term of the vacant seat, provision shall be immediately made for a special election to fill the vacancy, with the election to be held no sooner than 60 days and no later than 90 days after the seat has become vacant. The Governor shall call the special election if the vacancy is in the office of the judge of probate, and the judge of probate shall call the election if the vacancy is in the office of the revenue commissioner or the sheriff. The election, and, if necessary, any primary election or elections, shall be held in the manner prescribed by law, and the person elected to fill the vacancy shall serve for the remainder of the unexpired term.

Section 2. An election upon the proposed amendment shall be held in accordance with Amendment 555 to the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, now appearing as Section 284.01 of the Official Recompilation of the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, as amended, and the election laws of this state.

Section 3. The appropriate election official shall assign a ballot number for the proposed constitutional amendment on the election ballot and shall set forth the

following description of the substance or subject matter of 1 2 the proposed constitutional amendment: "Relating to Greene County, proposing an amendment 3 to the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, to provide for a 4 special election to fill a vacancy of the office of the judge 5 of probate, the revenue commissioner, or the sheriff. 6 "Proposed by Act ." 7 This description shall be followed by the following 8 9 language: 10 "Yes ( ) No ( )."
