> AN ACT

Relating to the membership of the Alabama Music Hall of Fame Board; to amend Section 41-9-680, Code of Alabama 1975, to change the current membership of the board; to provide for terms of service; and to provide for the annual election of a secretary and a treasurer. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

Section 1. Section 41-9-680, Code of Alabama 1975, is amended to read as follows:
"§41-9-680.
"(a) There shall be created and established as herein provided a board to be designated and known as the Alabama Music Hall of Fame Board. The Until the effective date of the act amending this section, the board shall be composed of seven members, who shall be appointed by the Governor of Alabama for terms of six years each; provided, that of the first members appointed under any restructured board, two shall serve for two years and two shall serve for four years,
as the Governor may direct. Four board members shall be appointed from the membership of the Muscle Shoals Music Association and three board members shall be appointed from the state at large and shall not be employed in the music business.
"(b) Effective immediately following the effective date of the act amending this section and adding this subsection, the board members as established by subsection (a) shall terminate service on the board and a new board shall be composed of the following members who shall each be a resident of Alabama:
"(1) Two members appointed by the Director of the Alabama Tourism Department for initial terms of office of four years. Successor members shall serve terms of office of six years.
"(2) Two members appointed by the Director of the Alabama Mountain Lakes Association for initial terms of office of four vears. Successor members shall serve terms of office of six years.
"(3) Two members appointed by the Governor for initial terms of office of two vears. Successor members shall serve terms of office of six years.
"(c) (1) The six members of the board appointed pursuant to subsection (b) shall take office immediately upon the effective date of this amendatory act and shall appoint, by a majority vote, one additional member for an initial term of office of two vears. Successor members shall serve terms of
office of six years. To the extent possible, the appointments shall be made so that no two members reside in the same congressional district.
"(2) The membership of the board shall be inclusive and reflect the racial, gender, geographic, urban/rural, and economic diversity of the state. The board shall annually report to the Legislature by the second legislative day of each regular session the extent to which the board has complied with the diversity provisions provided for in this subdivision.
"(3) Except for the initial seven new members appointed, successor members shall each serve terms of office of six years and may serve a total of two full terms of office.
"(d) Each October beginning in 2010, the members of the board shall select a ehairman chair, and vice-chairman a vice-chair, a secretary, and a treasurer from among their own number. Members of the board shall not be compensated for their services, but each member shall be entitled to reimbursement for expenses incurred in attending board meetings. The board shall meet quarterly and at such other times as its rules and bylaws may prescribe. A majority of the Four members shall constitute a quorum for transaction of business."

Section 2. This act shall become effective immediately following its passage and approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
