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6 ENROLLED, An Act,

7 Relating to Lowndes County; to authorize the county
8 commission to establish a contingent fund; and to establish
9 the amount which may be appropriated annually to the
10 contingent fund.

11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

12 Section 1. (a) Commencing with the fiscal year
13 beginning October 1, 2010, the Lowndes County Commission may
14 appropriate annually, out of the monies in the county treasury
15 not otherwise appropriated, an amount not exceeding ten
16 thousand dollars (\$10,000) into a fund to be known as the
17 "Contingent Fund," which may be expended for any county
18 purposes not otherwise provided by law which in the judgment
19 of the Lowndes County Commission are in the best interest of
20 the county. Any sums remaining unexpended in the contingent
21 fund at the end of the fiscal year shall not revert to the
22 county treasury, but the amount of unexpended funds shall be
23 appropriated for the next succeeding year along with any funds
24 which may be appropriated for that succeeding year provided

1 the amount appropriated or expended in any fiscal year shall
2 not exceed ten thousand dollars (\$10,000).

3 (b) The Lowndes County Commission may establish
4 procedures for the expenditure of the contingent fund.

5 Section 2. This act shall become effective
6 immediately following its passage and approval by the
7 Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
