23	Section 1. (a) For the purposes of this section, the
24	following terms have the following meanings:
25	(1) COVID-19. The virus for which the Governor
26	declared a public health emergency on March 13, 2020, or any
27	mutation thereof that results in an epidemic of which a public

health state of emergency is declared under the Alabama
Emergency Management Act of 1955.

- 3 (2) EMPLOYEE. An individual who is employed by an employer.
 - (3) EMPLOYER. A person in this state that, at any time, employs an individual or individuals who reside in this state to perform services of any nature. The term includes any individual who has control of the payment of wages for services or is the officer, agent, or employee of the individual having control of the payment of wages.
 - (b) No employer may compel receipt of a COVID-19 vaccine by any employee if that employee objects to vaccination for any reason of personal conscience, based on a religious belief, or for medical reasons, including prior recovery from COVID-19.

Section 2. This act shall become effective immediately following its passage and approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
