4 ENROLLED, An Act,

5 Relating to alcoholic beverages; to amend Section
6 28-3A-15, Code of Alabama 1975, to provide that a retail table
7 wine licensee may dispense wine for off-premises consumption
8 in containers approved by the board.

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

10 Section 1. Section 28-3A-15, Code of Alabama 1975,
11 is amended to read as follows:

12 "§28-3A-15.

13 "Upon applicant's compliance with the provisions of
14 this chapter and the ~~regulations made~~ rules adopted
15 thereunder, in counties and municipalities where authorized,
16 the board shall issue a retail table wine license for any
17 retail outlet, which license will authorize the licensee to
18 purchase table wine in packaged form from the board, or from
19 licensed wholesalers and to sell such table wines in original
20 unopened containers or in a container approved by the board at
21 retail for off-premises consumption, where such use of the
22 proposed location of the retail outlet is not, at the time of
23 original application, prohibited by a valid zoning ordinance
24 or other ordinance in the valid exercise of police power by

1 the governing body of the municipality or county in which the
2 retail outlet is located."

3 Section 2. This act shall become effective
4 immediately following its passage and approval by the
5 Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
