Relating to Chambers County; authorizing the county 3 commission to extend the ad valorem tax levied pursuant to 4 Section 45-9-242, Code of Alabama 1975; and providing for a 5 6 referendum.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA: 7

Section 1. Pursuant to subsection (f) of Amendment 8 No. 373 to the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, now appearing 9 10 as subsection (f) of Section 217 of the Recompilation of the 11 Constitution of Alabama 1901, as amended, the Chambers County 12 Commission may levy for a period of 20 years, in addition to 13 any other tax, an ad valorem tax in the amount of six mills on 14 each dollar of taxable property in the county. The ad valorem 15 tax authorized by this act is intended to authorize the 16 extension of the ad valorem tax levied pursuant to Section 17 45-9-242, Code of Alabama 1975, for an additional 20 years, 18 and the extension of the ad valorem tax pursuant to this act 19 may not commence until the expiration of that tax. The revenue from the additional tax shall be paid to the county general 20 21 fund to be distributed as follows:

(1) Three mills to the county and city boards of 23 education to be used for general education purposes.

1 (2) Three mills shall remain in the county general fund to be used for the construction and maintenance of roads 2 3 in the county. 4 Section 2. The extension of the tax as provided by this act is subject to the approval of a majority of the 5 qualified electors of the county who vote on the proposed 6 extension at the next run-off primary election in 2022. 7 Section 3. This act shall become effective 8 9 immediately following its passage and approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law. 10
