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To propose an amendment to the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, to merge the Office of State Auditor into the Office to the State Treasurer upon the expiration of the term of office of the State Auditor in January 2031; and to transfer the duty of the State Auditor to make an appointment to each local board of registrars to the State Treasurer.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

Section 1. The following amendment to the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, as amended, is proposed and shall become valid as a part thereof when approved by a majority of the qualified electors voting thereon and in accordance with Sections 284, 285, and 287 of the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, as amended:

PROPOSED AMENDMENT

The Office of State Auditor shall be merged into the Office of the State Treasurer upon the expiration of the term of office. No person shall be elected to the office as State Auditor for any term commencing after the expiration of the term of office in January 2031. After the expiration of that term of office, the separate Office of State Auditor is abolished and any reference to State Auditor in the this Constitution, any amendment thereto, or any other law, rule, or regulation shall be deemed to be a reference to the Office of the State Treasurer. Upon the merger of the Office of State Auditor, the functions, duties, and responsibilities which the State Auditor was previously responsible for shall be performed by the State Treasurer. The requirement that the

1 State Auditor appoint a member to each county board of 2 registrars pursuant to Section 17-3-2, Code of Alabama 1975, shall be transferred at that time to the State Treasurer 3 unless otherwise provided by law. 4 5 Section 2. An election upon the proposed amendment shall be held in accordance with Sections 284 and 285 of the 6 7 Constitution of Alabama of 1901, as amended, and the election laws of this state. 8 9 Section 3. The appropriate election official shall 10 assign a ballot number for the proposed constitutional amendment on the election ballot and shall set forth the 11 12 following description of the substance or subject matter of 13 the proposed constitutional amendment: 14 "Proposing an amendment to the Constitution of 15 Alabama of 1901, to merge the Office of State Auditor into the 16 Office of the State Treasurer upon expiration of the term of 17 office of the State Auditor in January 2031 and to transfer 18 the duty of the State Auditor to appoint a member to each county board of registrars to the State Treasurer at that 19 20 time. 21 "Proposed by Act ." 22 This description shall be followed by the following 23 language:
