18	Section 1. Section 1 of Act 258 of the 1975 Regular
19	Session (Acts 1975, p. 792), is amended to read as follows:
20	"Section 1.
21	"(a) The mayor of any municipality in Jefferson
22	County who is employed full-time by a municipality, municipal
23	board, or municipal public corporation, to serve as
24	superintendent of a municipal light and power system,
25	municipal water system, municipal sewage system and , or

municipal gas system, $\underline{\text{or}}$ one or more of them, owned and operated by such municipality, municipal board, or municipal public corporation pursuant to the provision of Title 37, Section 440, Alabama Code 1940 Section 11-43-80, Code of Alabama 1975, as amended, shall be paid for his or her service as superintendent of such the system or systems, in addition to the salary he or she now or hereafter receives as mayor, such the sum as the governing body, board, or municipal public corporation shall deem reasonable, but not to exceed Twelve Hundred Dollars (\$1,200.00) twelve hundred dollars (\$1,200) per month, notwithstanding the provisions of Title 37, Section Section 11-43-80, as amended, or any other law to the contrary.

"(b) Alternatively, notwithstanding subsection (a), the governing body or board of a municipality, municipal board, or municipal public corporation employing the mayor of any municipality in Jefferson County to serve as superintendent of a municipal light and power system, municipal water system, municipal sewage system, or municipal gas system, or one or more of them, owned and operated by the municipality, municipal board, or municipal public corporation, pursuant to the provisions of Section 11-43-80, Code of Alabama 1975, as amended, may adopt an ordinance or resolution electing for the municipality, municipal board, or municipal public corporation to be exempted from the

limitations of subsection (a) and, instead, to follow Section
11-43-80, as amended, or other applicable law.
"(c) This section shall not apply to the mayor of
the City of Bessemer."
Section 2. This act shall become effective
immediately following its passage and approval by the
Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
