21	of the act amending this section, the Judge of Probate of
22	Houston County shall receive an annual salary of one hundred
23	five thousand dollars (\$105,000). Notwithstanding Chapter 2A
24	of Title 11, the judge of probate shall be eligible for any
25	cost of living increase afforded to all county employees equal
26	to the state salary paid to a district judge, and shall be
27	entitled to any increases in salary in the same amount and

same manner as a district judge possessing the same number of 1 2 cumulative years of service as the probate judge at that time 3 possesses. "(2) The salary provided by this section shall be in 4 5 lieu of any and all other prior compensation or income, not including any expense allowance, provided by law for the judge 6 7 of probate, and shall be paid in equal periodic installments from the general fund of the county. 8 "(b) In order to receive the compensation provided 9 10 under subsection (a), the judge of probate shall waive any 11 compensation provided under Section 17-3-60, relating to
