2 ENROLLED, An Act,

3 Relating to motor vehicle registration receipt forms
4 and validation decals; to add Section 32-6-64.2 to the Code of
5 Alabama 1975; to allow a county licensing official to contract
6 with a third party, upon approval of the county commission, to
7 provide materials for print-on-demand validation decals,
8 emblems, and registration receipt forms; to provide that
9 amounts distributed to the Department of Corrections shall not
10 be reduced by such contracts; and to provide that such
11 contracts are subject to the procurement provisions of the
12 county.

13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

14 Section 1. Section 32-6-64.2 is added to the Code of
15 Alabama 1975, to read as follows:

16 §32-6-64.2.

17 (a) In lieu of being supplied validation decals,
18 emblems, and registration receipt forms directly from the
19 Department of Corrections or the Department of Revenue, county
20 licensing officials may contract with a third party, upon
21 approval by the county commission, to provide materials for
22 print-on-demand validation decals, emblems, and registration
23 receipt forms. The validation decals, emblems, and
24 registration receipt forms shall be subject to review and

1 approval by the Department of Revenue to ensure statewide uniformity.

2 (b) The amount distributed to the Department of
3 Corrections pursuant to this chapter, including Section
4 32-6-64.1, or any other provision of law, shall not be reduced
5 by any contract entered into by a county licensing official
6 pursuant to this section, nor shall any contract entered into
7 pursuant to this section be interpreted to apply to or extend
8 to registrations issued under Chapter 5 of Title 33.

9 (c) Contracts entered into pursuant to this section
10 shall be subject to the procurement requirements of the
11 licensing official's county.

12 (d) The Department of Revenue may adopt rules for
13 the implementation and administration of this section.

14 Section 2. This act shall become effective
15 immediately following its passage and approval by the
16 Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
