SYNOPSIS: This bill would create a 180 day grace
period between an inmate's release from
incarceration and the due date of the inmate's
legal financial obligations.

A BILL
TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT

Relating to court-imposed fines, fees, and costs; to
provide for a grace period for fines, fees, and costs upon
release from custody.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

Section 1. During the 180 day period immediately
after an inmate is released from custody, he or she shall not
be required to pay any outstanding court-assessed fines, fees,
or costs. This section shall not apply to any supervision fees
assessed as a condition of release from custody.

1 Section 2. This act shall become effective on the
2 first day of the third month following its passage and
3 approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
