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2 ENROLLED, An Act,

To amend Sections 41-9-550, 41-9-551, and 41-9-552, Code of Alabama 1975, relating to the Alabama Women's Hall of Fame; to revise the membership of the board; to authorize the membership of the board to meet electronically; to provide further for the location of the hall; and to require all new honorees to be deceased for at least two years before selection.

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BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

Section 1. Sections 41-9-550, 41-9-551, and 41-9-552 of the Code of Alabama 1975, are amended to read as follows: "\$41-9-550.

14 "There is created and established a board to be 15 designated and known as the Alabama Women's Hall of Fame. The 16 board shall be composed of 11 members with at least one member 17 chosen from each of the following fields: politics, Politics, art, education, business, law, community service, medicine, 18 19 religion, and science. The initial members of the board shall 20 be appointed by the Governor. In addition, the Governor and 21 the President of Judson College president or chief executive 22 officer of the institution that hosts the hall shall serve as 23 voting members of the board. The executive secretary shall 24 serve as a nonvoting member of the board. The board shall meet 25 semiannually and at other times as its rules and bylaws may

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1 prescribe. A quorum of five members of the board shall be 2 present for business to be conducted. The board may meet and transact any of its business by telephone means of telephone 3 conference, video conference, or similar communications 4 equipment by means of which all board members participating in 5 6 the meeting may hear each other at the same time. 7 Participation by these means shall constitute presence in 8 person at a meeting for all purposes, provided written notice 9 is given to all board members 10 days prior to the date of the 10 meeting public notice of the meeting is in accordance with the 11 Open Meetings Act. The members of the board shall not be compensated for their services, but each member shall be 12 13 entitled to reimbursement for expenses incurred in attending 14 board meetings. Members of the board shall serve for terms of 15 three years. The board shall fill vacancies as they occur and 16 shall have the full and final right of choosing succeeding 17 members. The members of the board shall coordinate their appointments so that diversity of race and geographical areas 18 is reflective of the makeup of this state. The chair shall be 19 20 elected annually. The executive secretary shall serve at the 21 pleasure of the board. 22

"§41-9-551.

"The board shall be domiciled at Judson College, 23 24 Marion, Perry County, where it shall maintain such implement 25 and maintain with a public or private institution an agreement HB100

1 under which the institution shall provide halls, rooms, or 2 quarters as may be considered suitable and appropriate for conducting its the affairs of the board. Judson College shall 3 4 cause to be set apart a section thereof to be used by the 5 board for display of plaques, busts, books, papers, pictures 6 and for displaying plaques and other memorabilia relating to women of achievement. The board may negotiate, enter, and 7 8 sever these agreements as necessary to serve the purposes of 9 the board. "§41-9-552. 10 11 "It shall be the function and main purpose of the board to honor those women of Alabama who have rendered 12 13 outstanding services or have won fame on account of their 14 achievements. It The board shall elect and induct to the

15 Alabama Women's Hall of Fame such those women who are 16 nominated for election and who receive a unanimous vote of the 17 board of directors with at least a quorum of the board present 18 and voting unanimously. The installation of each elected 19 member of the Alabama Women's Hall of Fame may occur on a 20 separate occasion so as to focus attention on the individual 21 contribution of each honoree. No more than two new New members 22 of the hall shall be selected each year, and these new members 23 must be deceased, for a minimum of two years, at the time of 24 their selection. Nominations shall be received from the 25 public."

Section 2. This act shall become effective on the
first day of the third month following its passage and
approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
