Relating to public K-12 schools; to require a public K-12 school to credit a student who participates in an activity or program sponsored by 4-H or the Future Farmers of America (FFA) during school hours as present in class during the participation, with certain exceptions; to provide for make-up of classwork for such a student; and to prohibit adverse treatment of a student's grades due to participation in 4-H or FFA events.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

Section 1. (a) Beginning in the 2023-2024 school year, a student of a public K-12 school who participates in an activity or program sponsored by 4-H or the Future Farmers of America (FFA) during school hours shall be credited as present in class by the school. A faculty member of a public K-12 school shall not count a student absent for participating in any activity or program sponsored by 4-H or FFA. For the purposes of this section, the term "school hours" means any time during which a student is expected to be present for classroom instruction or a related activity, and attendance of students is taken.

(b) Upon request from a faculty member, or his or her designee, of a public K-12 school, a 4-H or FFA agent shall provide documentation as proof of a student's participation in an activity or program sponsored by 4-H or FFA, as applicable.

(c) A public K-12 school shall give a student the opportunity to make up any school work missed while the student was participating in an activity or program sponsored by 4-H or FFA, and a student's grades shall not be adversely impacted for lack of attendance or participation due to his or her participation in an activity or program sponsored by 4-H or FFA.

(d) Notwithstanding subsection (a), a faculty member of a public K-12 school, or his or her designee, shall not credit a student who participates in an activity or program sponsored by 4-H or FFA as present in class if the student's participation occurs during any period of time for which the student has been suspended, expelled, or assigned to an alternative school or alternative program if the student's suspension, expulsion, or assignment to an alternative school or alternative program would otherwise preclude the student from participation.

Section 2. This act shall become effective on the first day of the third month following its passage and approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
