12 (3) BOARD. The Board of Trustees of the Alabama13 Trust Fund.

(b) Except as otherwise provided by Amendment 450, members of the board or any committee established by the board may participate in a meeting of the board or committee by means of telephone conference, video conference, or similar communications equipment by means of which all persons participating in the meeting may hear each other at the same time.

(c) Participation by means authorized in this
section shall constitute presence in person at a meeting for
all purposes, including the establishment of a quorum, to
deliberate and take action.

(d) The telephone or video conference or other
similar communications equipment shall also allow members of
the public the opportunity to simultaneously listen to or

observe meetings held pursuant to this section, to the same extent required by Amendment 450 for public participation at meetings.

4 (e) (1) The facilities of the State Treasurer shall
5 be used in the administration of the Alabama Trust Fund,
6 including the scheduling and notification of meetings.

7 (2) The State Treasurer shall give notice of any
8 meeting held pursuant to this section in the same manner
