25	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:
26	Section 1. Section 28-3A-15, Code of Alabama 1975,
27	is amended to read as follows:

"§28-3A-15.

2 "Upon applicant's compliance with the provisions of 3 this chapter and the regulations made rules adopted thereunder, in counties and municipalities where authorized, 4 the board shall issue a retail table wine license for any 5 retail outlet, which license will authorize the licensee to 6 7 purchase table wine in packaged form from the board, or from licensed wholesalers and to sell such table wines in original 8 unopened containers or in a container approved by the board at 9 10 retail for off-premises consumption, where such use of the proposed location of the retail outlet is not, at the time of 11 original application, prohibited by a valid zoning ordinance 12 13 or other ordinance in the valid exercise of police power by 14 the governing body of the municipality or county in which the 15 retail outlet is located."

16 Section 2. This act shall become effective 17 immediately following its passage and approval by the 18 Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
