2 ENROLLED, An Act,

Relating to Jefferson County and the General 3 Retirement System for employees of the county; to amend 4 Section 45-37-123.54 of the Code of Alabama 1975, to eliminate 5 6 the reduction to the pension benefit of a member who is receiving a pension on account of retirement and is reemployed 7 8 by the county two or more years after the member severs 9 employment from the county; to repeal Section 45-37-123.105 of the Code of Alabama 1975, providing for an offset of 10 11 retirement or disability benefits, including worker's 12 compensation, of a retired member who is reemployed by the county; and to specify prospective application of this act. 13 14 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

Section 1. 45-37-123.54 of the Code of Alabama 1975, is amended to read as follows:

"§45-37-123.54.

"If a member of the system severs employment with the county or his or her term in an elected or appointed job or position terminates, and such member thereafter returns to the service of the county, he or she shall become a member of the system to the extent he or she meets the definition of an eligible employee, subject to the following rules:

"(1) MEMBER RECEIVING A PENSION BENEFIT. <u>If a member</u>
 receiving his or her pensions benefit is reemployed by the

1 county two or more years after severing employment, the 2 pension benefit of the member shall not be reduced. If a member is receiving his or her pension benefit on account of 3 4 retirement and such member returns to the service of and is 5 reemployed by the county less than two years after severing 6 employment, any amount otherwise payable by the system to such member on account of such member's retirement shall be reduced 7 8 by the amount, if any, paid or payable to such member by the 9 county on account of or by reason of the reemployment of such 10 member. At the earlier of the time the member thereafter 11 severs employment with the county or after two or more years of reemployment by the county, such member's pension benefit 12 13 shall return to the amount it was prior to the member's 14 reemployment. Accordingly However, notwithstanding 15 subdivisions (3) and (4), such a member covered by this 16 subdivision shall not accrue any additional pension benefit 17 during his or her period of rehire reemployment.

"(2) MEMBER ELECTED A DEFERRED RETIREMENT. If a 18 19 vested member who severed employment with the county and elected a deferred retirement benefit is reemployed by the 20 21 county before age 60, his or her election for a deferred 22 retirement benefit shall be rescinded, and he or she shall 23 begin to accrue benefits again upon the date of reemployment. 24 Such member's benefit shall be calculated by aggregating the 25 member's credited service during all periods of employment.

1 "(3) MEMBER DOES NOT RECEIVE A REFUND AND IS 2 REEMPLOYED WITHIN FIVE YEARS. Except as set forth in subdivision (1), if a member, who severed employment with the 3 county but did not receive a refund of his or her employee 4 5 contributions to the system as provided in Section 6 45-37-123.104, is reemployed by the county within five years of such severance from employment, he or she shall begin to 7 8 accrue benefits again upon the date of reemployment. Such member's benefit shall be calculated by aggregating the 9 10 member's credited service during all periods of employment.

11 "(4) MEMBER RECEIVED A REFUND OR FORFEITED PENSION BENEFIT. Except as set forth in subdivision (1), if a member 12 13 who severed employment with the county and received a refund 14 of his or her employee contributions to the system as provided 15 in Section 45-37-123.104, or does not receive a refund within 16 five years after severing from employment, is reemployed by 17 the county, he or she shall rejoin the system in accordance with Sections 45-37-123.50 and 45-37-123.82 and begin to 18 19 accrue benefits again upon the date of reemployment. In calculating such member's benefit, only credited service 20 21 rendered after the member is rehired reemployed shall be included." 22

Section 2. Section 45-37-123.105 of the Code of
Alabama 1975, is repealed.

Section 3. This act shall apply prospectively only
 to retired members of the system who are reemployed by the
 county on or after the effective date of this act.
 Section 4. This act shall become effective
 immediately following its passage and approval by the
