2 ENROLLED, An Act, Relating to the Board of Trustees of The University 3 of West Alabama; to authorize the board to hold certain 4 meetings by telephone or video conference, or by similar means 5 6 under certain conditions. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA: 7 Section 1. Section 16-53-4, Code of Alabama, is 8 amended to read as follows: 9 "\$16-53-4. 10 11 "(a) The Board of Trustees of The University of West 12 Alabama shall hold its regular annual meeting each year at the 13 institution on the first Monday in June, unless the board 14 shall in regular session determine to hold its meeting at some 15 other time and place. Thereafter, the board shall hold 16 quarterly meetings on the first Monday of each third month 17 after the annual meeting, unless the board shall in regular session determine to hold its quarterly meeting at some other 18 19 time or place. Special meetings of the board may be assembled by either one of the two methods outlined as follows: 20 21 "(1) Special meetings of the board may be called by 22 the Governor. In calling such special meetings, the Governor shall mail a written notice to each trustee at least 10 days 23 24 in advance of the date of such meetings.

1 "(2) Upon the application in writing of any eight 2 members of the board, the Governor shall call a special meeting, naming the time and place thereof and causing notices 3 to be issued in writing to the several members of the board. 4 5 Such Special meetings shall not be held on a date less than 10 6 days subsequent to the notice from the Governor. "(b)(1) Members of the board may participate in a 7 meeting of the board or any committee of the board by 8 telephone conference, video conference, or similar 9 10 communications equipment by means of which all persons 11 participating in the meeting may hear each other at the same 12 time. Participation by these electronic means shall constitute 13 presence in person at the meeting for all purposes, including 14 the establishment of a quorum; provided that at least one 15 board member is physically present at the location noticed and 16 called for the meeting. However, a majority of a quorum of 17 the members of the board, or, in the event of a meeting of only the executive committee, a majority of a quorum of the 18 19 executive committee of the board shall be physically present at the location noticed and called for the meeting in order to 20 21 conduct any business or deliberation.

"(2) Members of the board and any committees of the
board may not utilize electronic communications except as in
compliance with the Alabama Open Meetings Act. Except for
emergency meetings, notice Notice of board meetings shall be

1 provided in accordance with the Alabama Open Meetings Act and 2 telephone or video conference or similar communications Except for emergency meetings, notice (2) The telephone or 3 video conference or similar communications equipment shall 4 5 also allow members of the public the opportunity to 6 simultaneously listen to or observe the meetings. 7 (3) Except as specifically provided otherwise by this section, meetings using communications equipment as 8 authorized by this section shall be conducted in compliance 9 10 with the Alabama Open Meetings Act. 11 "(c) The executive committee of the board and other 12 committees of the board shall hold meetings at such times and 13 on such dates as the board of trustees may provide." 14 Section 2. This act shall become effective on the 15 first day of the third month following its passage and 16 approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
